


PUBLIC SENTIMENT

In October 2021, the Siletz Tribe enlisted DHM Research to conduct a poll of 594 Salem and Keizer-area residents to determine public sentiment about a local casino. Here are the key results:


AREA SUPPORT

North and northeast Salem residents are among the most supportive of the project.




SUSTAINED SUPPORT

Resident support for the project is similar or higher than a similar study conducted in 2017.



RESIDENT SUPPORT

A strong majority of residents support a Salem-area casino, including nearly every demographic group.



VISITING THE CASINO

76% Tribal revenue sharing


73% Transportation improvements
